The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. 7. Reverse Auction would be conducted amongst first 50% of the technically qualified bidders arranged in the order of prices from lowest to highest. #### **(6) Other Essential Requirements**

- Each color comparison chart for specific test must include the required acceptable limit and permissible limit of BIS (IS 10500: 2012) ranges.
- Minimum 04 color comparison should be provided.
- The color comparison should be clear and distinct, so that any person performing the test can easily understand.
- The color comparison charts should be properly laminated.

- Provisions for color measurement should be on vertically comparing (not horizontally). For this, the test tubes should have flat base.
- Test method procedure should be efficient and easy to perform.
- Each chemical, reagent bottle/tablet pouch should be labelled properly with chemical name and strength according to the procedure in Hindi.
- Date of manufacturing, batch number and expiry date should be mentioned on all reagents/chemicals provided in the kit.
- Test method procedure should be provided in Hindi and laminated properly.
- The reagents provided should have self-life of minimum 02 years and hazardous chemicals should be marked distinctly.
- The main reagent for fluoride test is Xylonol-Orange in liquid form, which is developed and based on Bhabha Atomic Research Centre (BARC) technology. Hence, manufacturer/supplier should have technology transfer/license from BARC, Mumbai.
