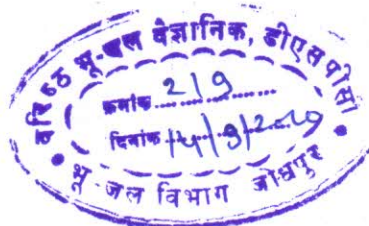

RESOLUTION

(as amended upto 31st January, 1953)

F.45-74/49-Policy,

New Delhi, the 6th December, 1949

The Government of India have had under examination the possibilities of tapping underground water resources in Rajasthan. Preliminary borings made in several places have proved that large supplies of water can be made available for agricultural purposes throughout the year in areas now wholly dependent on inadequate and uncertain rainfall during the monsoon months. The development of these sources of water in this region is of utmost importance, both for Rajasthan and the country as a whole. It has, therefore, been decided to set up a Rajasthan Underground Water Board to direct exploration and development of the underground water resources of Rajasthan and also of such other areas as may be specified by the Government of India, Ministry of Food and Agriculture from time to time.

CONSTITUTION OF THE BOARD.

1. Minister for Agriculture, Govt. of India Ex-officio Chairman
2. Chief Minister, Rajasthan:- Ex-officio Vice Chairman
3. Minister for Irrigation, Rajasthan Member.
4. Shri Raj Bahadur, Deputy Minister for Communications, Government of India:- Member.
5. Chief Secretary to the Govt. of Rajasthan:- Member.
6. Production Commissioner & ex-officio Additional Secretary, Ministry of Food & Agriculture:- Member.
7. Shri S.T. Raja, Deputy Secretary, Ministry of Food & Agriculture:- Executive Member.
8. Irrigation Adviser to the Govt. of India, Ministry of Food & Agriculture:- Member.
9. Chief Engineer, Irrigation, Rajasthan:- Member.
10. Thakur Bhawani Singh of Pokaran, M.P. Jodhpur Member.
11. Asst. Officer cum Engineer-in-Charge, Rajasthan Under Ground Water Board nominated by the Central Government:- Secretary.

FUNCTIONS AND POWERS.

The functions and powers of the Board shall be

to plan and conduct of operations for exploring the underground resources of Rajasthan and also such other areas as may be specified by the Government of India, Ministry of Food and Agriculture from time to time.

making preliminary utilisation of the water resources discovered and ascertaining their irrigational possibilities for the region covered by each series of borings.

As Rajasthan lies in the 'oil belt' the Board may, in the course of its operations, undertake preliminary exploration of all resources of this area in consultation with and cooperation of the Geological Survey of India.

The Government of India may in consultation with the Rajasthan Government, direct that the Board shall carry out such additional functions and exercise such additional powers as may be specified from time to time.



FUNDS AND EQUIPMENT.

The Board shall have its own fund provided by annual block grant by the Government of India and Rajasthan. The Board shall have powers to incur such expenditure as it thinks necessary to carry out its functions. The Board shall in October each year, prepare in such form as may be prescribed a budget for the next financial year showing the estimated expenditure and the receipts, if any, and the amounts required for its operations during the ensuing year. The budget will be prepared by the Secretary, and after approval by the Board, will be referred to the Government of India for approval of the Ministries of Agriculture and Finance. The Board will adjust its activities and operations within the amount sanctioned for each year including such supplementary grants as may be placed at its disposal.

The Government of India will place at the disposal of the Board such machinery and equipment and spare parts as are available from time to time for the purpose of utilisation in its operations. The initial equipment and machinery which will be transferred to the control of this Board from the Central Ground Water Organisation is mentioned in Schedule I.

5. Power to appoint staff.

The Board shall have final powers to appoint, control and discharge staff and fix their salaries and scales of pay within the budget amount and within the scales prescribed by the Government of India for similar staff in different grades.

6. Headquarters of the Board.

The headquarters of the Board shall be at Jaipur. The Board may, however, also meet at New Delhi, when required in the interests of its work.

7. Accounts and Audit.

The accounts of the Board and Exploration Unit and a stock Register of all machinery and equipment transferred to the Board shall be maintained and audited in such manner as may be prescribed, in consultation with the Auditor General of India.

8. Annual Report.

The Board shall prepare in such form as may be prescribed, an annual report within three months after the end of each financial year, including an account of its activities and a statement of income and expenditure for the year.....

9. Relations with the Central Government.

In the discharge of its functions the Board will be guided by such instructions on questions of policy as may be given to it by the Central Government.

10. Ordered that a copy of the Resolution be communicated to all Provincial Governments, Local Administrations; State Unions, States, all Ministries and Departments of the Government of India, Cabinet Secretariat, Prime Minister's Secretariat, Indian Trade Commissioners.

Ordered also that it may be published in the Gazette of India.

R E S O L U T I O N

The Rajasthan Under Ground Water Board was set up under Government of India resolution No.F.45-74/49-Policy dated 6th December, 1949 in order to promote and conduct operations for exploring the ground water resources of Rajasthan and also for making preliminary utilisation of the water resources thus discovered for demonstrating irrigation possibilities. The Board has been undertaking construction of new tubewells and deepening of existing open wells at the request of private parties etc., and on advance payment basis. It has functioned for the last few years under the active guidance of the Ministry of Food and Agriculture and is now a regular running organisation with an income of its own. As the activities of the Board were intended mainly to benefit the scarcity areas of Rajasthan only, and as it is running on proper lines, the Government of India considered that the stage had come when the control of the Board should appropriately be taken over by the Government of Rajasthan. The Board accepted the proposed transfer in principle at its annual meeting held on 14th March, 1954 and recommended that the transfer be effected from 1st April, 1955. On further consideration of the proposal, the Government of India decided with the concurrence of the Government of Rajasthan.
